## COVID – 19 GUIDELINES

Open Door will abide by the Covid-19 guidelines as set forth by the CDC, Maryland State Department of Education, Maryland Department of Health, and officials in local jurisdictions, including:

- Daily temperature checks and health screenings for staff and students.
- Maintaining small groups of no more than 14. Students will remain in their groups all day and groups are not able to mix.
- Staff and students are required to wear a mask at all times.
- Gloves will be used when necessary (food handling, cleaning, sanitizing, first aid and personal contact).
- Social distancing of 6 feet will be adhered to. Floor markers will be used to designate a safe distance.
- Supplies and toys will not be shared between students. All supplies and toys will be sanitized after each use and before being given to another child in care.
- Frequent hand washing by staff and students throughout the day, between activities and after use of equipment.
- Continuous cleaning and sanitizing of high touch points using CDC approved disinfectant and practices.

These enhanced safety measures are designed to reduce the potential spread of covid-19. If a suspected case arises, it will be reported to the health department immediately. Open Door will abide by any direction given by the Health Department and the Office of Child Care as to closure or quarantining of students and staff and will communicate with the families who may be impacted via phone and/or email with information and instructions from the health department.
